Lead a brief discussion with students using the following questions:

- 1. At the beginning of the story, Henry's extensive calculations reveal some disturbing data.
 - What are the troubling things that show that the prophecy of four could unfortunately come true?
 - According to Noé, what would happen if the prophecy were to come true?
 - Have you ever had a feeling and followed your instincts? Explain.
- 2. As Henry explains his theory, the people at the Agency realize that he is very superstitious.
 - What proves that Henry truly believes these stories?
 - Are you superstitious like Henry? Why?
 - Name four other superstitions.
- 3. When Jon finds himself in the Redlands, he loses his memory and believes he is Borius Reginolf.
 - Do you think Jon's memory loss helped him in his mission? Explain.
 - How is his memory restored?
 - Have you ever had a memory lapse?
- 4. Via satellite images, Martha realizes that Jon is unfortunately in the company of an old friend and colleague.
 - Why do Martha and Cassandra no longer work together?
 - Does Martha manage to reason with Cassandra so that she abandons her terrible plans?
 - What do you think would make it possible for her to have a good working relationship with her teammates?
- 5. To carry out their plans, Cassandra and the Rebel Club go to the Fang of Eternal Suffering to bring someone important from the Redlands back to life.
 - Who is that being and why do they want to bring him back to life?
 - How do they go about it?
 - What do they discover when the being comes back to life? Do you think he is a threat to the Agency?

Before working for the Agency, you need some experience in the field. Ask students to create their own group of law enforcers to eventually be hired by the Agency.

In teams, using paper, pencils and your imagination, come up with your own team of enforcers:
